If you download by sourceforge, follow the steps below.

2.1 - Download and install VirtualBox for your operating system.

2.2 - Download and install Vagrant for your operating system.

2.3 – Download the file CitsmartITSM-community-6.1.2.2.zip and unzip it.

2.4 - Access the directory where the files were extracted, double click on the start of your system.

2.4.1 - start\_microsoft.bat for Windows;

2.4.2 - start\_linux.sh for Linux;

2.4.3 - start\_mac.command for Mac OS.


